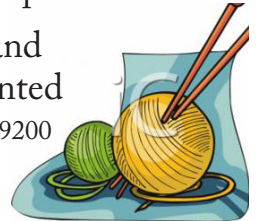

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE



H.R. 3200 – America’s Affordable Health Choices Act of 2009



The Chamber continues to support reforming the healthcare system, specifically efforts to control costs and improve quality, insurance market reforms and the creation of a streamlined, simplified marketplace to purchase insurance.

However, bills in both the House and the Senate fail a simple litmus test for healthcare reform legislation: in their current form, these proposals do not improve the current situation – in fact, they will largely make it worse.

Tax increases to pay for a public plan, employer mandates and minimum coverage will do more than devastate the private insurance industry – they could bankrupt our economy.

This type of healthcare reform would bankrupt our government and leave hundreds of millions of Americans without the health care they deserve. Tell Congress to oppose the creation of a “public plan,” burdensome employer mandates and minimum coverage requirements.
